There will be a State Conference Committee Meeting on Sunday January 27th at 12 noon.

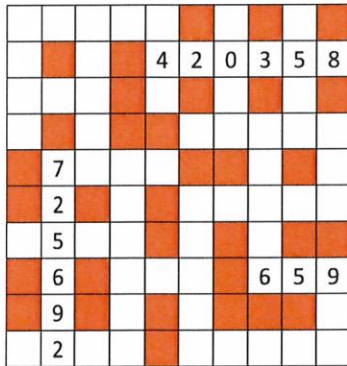
We could use all the help we can get for this State Conference Weekend.
