When submitting an Aerie application:

- A. Check appropriate block at top of form. (Aerie/New/Renew)
- B. Write on form: Vet, Police, EMS, Fire, Active Duty, etc.
- C. Attach \$36.00 to the form for Application Fee. Everyone pays the Application fee. Turn package into Aerie Secretary for action.
- D. The 1st or 2nd proposer MUST attend next Aerie meeting and speak on the application. The application stops here if NO ONE speaks on the application.
- E. Ensure your applicant gets to their interview. Our Interviewing Committee will notify your applicant when to be present for the interview.
- F. Ensure your applicant gets to our initiation. Must have \$36.00 Initiation Fee. Unless item (B.) is in effect. Aerie 3204 initiates on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Try and get the applicant here on initiation night no later than 6:30 pm.
- G. Please do your best when writing, if you can't read it neither can I.
