Please fill in all the information on the sign in book page. It should be should be neat and legible.

To provide clarification to the members. From the Aerie Bylaws concerning sign ins.

Section 3.1 A <u>non-member</u> residing WITHIN one hundred (100) miles of Aerie #3204 premises may not be a guest at the Aerie more than two (2) times within any thirty (30) day period and not to exceed more than four (4) months. (REV 12/07/2017)

Section 3.2 Non-members resideing OUTSIDE of one hundred (100) miles of Aerie #3204 premises may be signed in no more than twelve (12) times a year. (REV 12/07/2017)

A member who forgets their dues card, may be signed in by another member not to exceed two (2) times within a thirty (30) day period. If after the 2nd sign in, a request for a duplicated card should be submitted if membership is current. If member has been dropped from the roster a membership application must be completed and must be signed in untill intiation.

Liquor bottles: The shelves are getting full. There will be a 2 bottle limit. The extra bottle will be stored for a limited time at which point the owners should have a locker(s). The trustees have liquor lockers available for \$10.00 dollars.

Reminder: In the absence of a trustee, the bartender is in charge, and has the final say of all matters. If a member or guest is engaged in a conversation with the bartender asking a question(s) the bartender is the one to answer the question or questions. The individual asking the question(s) does not need to have all members giving different answers. Be courteous and let the bartender answer the questions.

Profanity: We are a family organization. Profanity is on the upraise again. Please curtail the profanity. If it becomes excessive, the bartenders may ask you leave.
