Paul Lubno is a Husband, Father, Grandfather, Stock Car Driver and an Eagle. He is also the winningest Grand Stock driver at the Langley Speedway in its 76 year history. Aerie 3204 is proud to be a sponsor of Paul's #14 Grand Stock car.

On April 11 he progressed through the qualifiers to take the pole position in the final race, and then proceeded to win the first 40-lap finale of the season with a time of 23 minutes and 51 seconds. The next weekend, Paul repeated with another Grand Stock win.

With the support of his family and a loyal crew, Paul continues his racing adventures at Langley and, at 60 years old, retirement seems to be a word missing from his vocabulary. "As long as I can keep crawling through that window" he said recently about racing, "I'm going to keep doing it."

Langley Speedway has been home to stock car racing's biggest names like Richard Petty, Jimmie Johnson, Chase Elliott, Denny Hamlin, and former track champions Brenden Queen and Connor Hall, as well as local drivers like Paul whose love of the sport can be seen each Saturday night from March to October. Over the course of the last 20 years, Langley Speedway has seen multi-million dollar renovations to its facility, upholding its current status as one of the top short tracks in the country, and it's right here in our backyard.

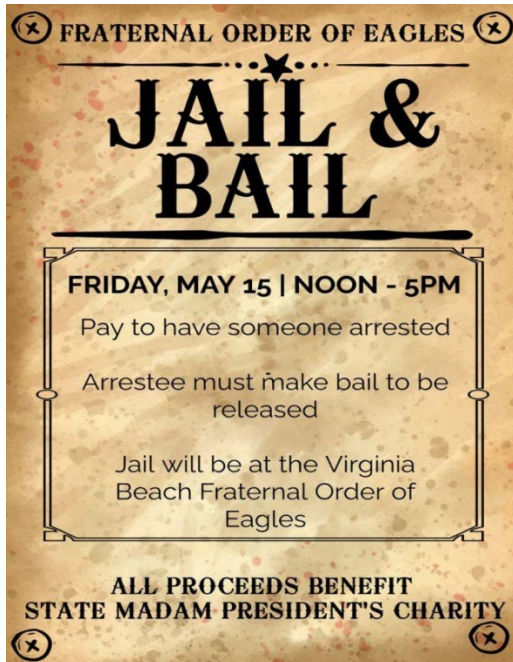

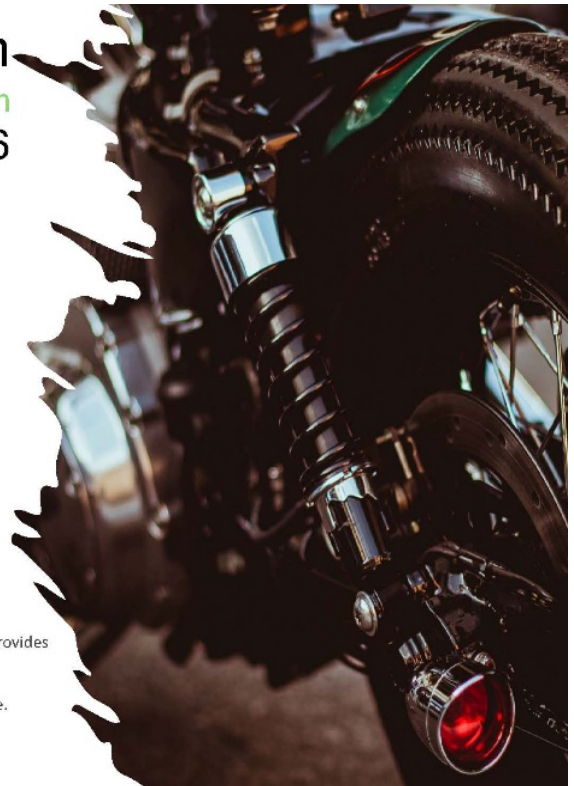
